### Election Official (EO)

---

The District of Tumbler Ridge is seeking to hire a number of high-energy individuals to work as Election Officials (Eos) during the 2022 Local Government Election. The ideal candidate will have the experience, knowledge and skills to carry out the duties of the EO at the voting location. The EO will be required to successfully complete a mandatory training session in September 2022. Preference is given to applicants who have a valid BC driver's licence and access to vehicle.

**Duration:** Mandatory Training Session – September 27, 2022  
General Voting Day – October 15, 2022  
Advanced Voting Opportunities - October 5 & 12, 2022

**Eligibility:**

- Be 18 years of age or older;
- Legally able to work in Canada (you do not have to be a Canadian Citizen to apply);
- Be responsible for their own transportation to and from the voting place;
- Attend a mandatory training session on September 27, 2022;
- Attention to detail and strong customer service skills required;
- As a condition of working any local government election, all election workers are required to make a solemn declaration that they will faithfully and impartially fulfill their duties, and that they are not personally connected with any candidate in the election;
- Not be actively working for any election campaign or any candidate; and
- Be Available to work on October 5, 12 and extended hours on Election Day, Saturday, October 15, 2022.

**Pay Rate:**

Election Officials will be paid \$25 per hour.
