Position Title: Aquatic Leader Trainee

Department: Community Services – Aquatic Centre

Reports To: Aquatic Supervisor

Job Purpose/Summary:

Under the direction of the Aquatic Supervisor or his/her named delegate (so named) Aquatic Leader 2, the incumbent instructs swim lessons and other related water programs, life guards, public swim lessons, and can involve instructing water fitness classes. This is a part time position and may involve weekend, afternoon and evening shifts. This is an entry level position, which provides for the trainee to achieve higher aquatic qualifications and provide coverage in the event of staff shortages.

Examples of Work:

1. Required to lifeguard public swim sessions ensuring the safety and enjoyment of all patrons in and out of the water.
2. Performs routine maintenance functions including the hosing of public change rooms and deck areas.
3. Maintains a positive relationship with the general public, promoting a positive leisure environment.
4. Leads “fun activities” during public swim sessions creating an enjoyable leisure environment for all patrons
5. Performs routine cashiering duties as required.
6. Other related duties and responsibilities as assigned.

Knowledge, Skills and Requirements:

1. Must hold current awards and certificates as follows:
 - National Lifeguard Service
 - CPR Level “C”/Standard First Aid

Working Conditions:

Work schedule will include shift work as required to meet program demands. As an Aquatic trainee, the incumbent will not be entitled to the benefits and conditions of employment as established in the C.U.P.E. Local 2979 Collective Agreement.
