CAMPFIRE BAN SCHEDULED TO BE LIFTED FOR DISTRICT OF TUMBLER RIDGE

Effective at 12:00pm on August 27th, 2021, the District of Tumbler Ridge is rescinding the campfire ban within the municipal boundary. The Category 2 and 3 open burning restrictions will remain in line with the Provincial Open Burning Restrictions that are currently in effect.
